Health Safety Protocols at Government House

As we navigate the continued social distancing requirements resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, the health and safety of the Governor, staff and all visitors to Government House remains of the highest priority.

Entry to Government House is subject to all guests following the health and safety protocols outlined in this document. Guests who are unwilling to comply with these protocols will be unable to enter the Government House Estate.

Prior to arriving at Government House

- ✿ Please stay at home if you feel unwell.
- ✿ Guests with smart phones are strongly encouraged to download the COVIDSafe app developed by the Australian Government.
- ✿ Please comply with the latest health advice issued by the Queensland Government.

On arrival at Government House

- ✿ Each guest will have their temperature taken using an infrared forehead thermometer.
- ✿ Each guest will be required to complete a *Coronavirus (COVID-19) Health Self-Declaration* form that will be provided to each guest on arrival.
- ✿ Hand sanitisation stations are positioned within Government House for your safety and use.
- ✿ Please ensure social distancing while at Government House at all times, including:
 - no physical contact and no shaking hands; and
 - maintaining a physical distance of at least 1.5 metres from other guests and staff.
